DAY OF PARADE DETAILS

Parade Route

The parade runs south down Northumberland St. from Inglis, turning left onto Stanley St at the Cenotaph and concluding at the Ayr Public Library. The route is the same as the yearly Ayr Santa Claus Parade.

Pre-Parade

Please arrive at the parade form-up area (Inglis Str. / Premier Spring location) no later than 9:30 am so we are able to place you in your specific designated spot. Parade begins at 10:30am. When you arrive, please approach a Lions Club member in a bright yellow Lions vest, if you require assistance to your designated number in the parade.

Parking

Parking where the parade forms up on Inglis will not be permitted, therefore we suggest you park along one of the nearby side streets.

Post-Parade

To return to the parade form-up area at the conclusion of the parade, continue along Stanley St, which then becomes Main St after the bend. Continue over the single lane bridge (10-Tonne max capacity!) to Hall St. Turn left onto Hall St and proceed to Willison St. (first stop sign). Turn right onto Willison and take it to the end, which is Inglis St. Turn left onto Inglis and you will return to the parade form-up area.
